## Frederick Howard Buttel (1948–2005)

Professor Frederick H. Buttel who was born in Freeport, Illinois on 15 October 1948, died in Madison, Wisconsin on 14 January 2005.

Professor Buttel graduated from the universities of Wisconsin and Yale and received a Ph.D. in sociology from the university of Wisconsin-Madison in 1975. He was professor of rural sociology and ecological studies at Wisconsin-Madison until his last days.

He was a member of the Advisory Council of "Eastern European Countryside" for the past ten years.
